Advanced training in Shinyo - Shingen - Kappo

What is Okugi? This is an advanced training session for secret or prioritized knowledge. What are Shinyo no Maki and Shingen no Maki? These are the last and highest boards in the Kodenkan Jujitsu system of Prof. H.S. Okazaki.

What is Kappo? Kappo is the art of resuscitation and treatment for specific injuries.

Rank requirements for participation

This advanced certification course will be open to all brown belt ranks and above. Students must be proficient in throwing and falling (Nage and Ukemi Waza). Non - Jujitsuka and Judoka practitioners as well as special circumstances will need approval.

Course Instructors

This advanced certification course will be instructed by the Jujitsu America Board of Professors and Standards Board.
