

Second Annual American Combat Jujitsu Two Day Convention

Professor Tony “the Bear” Maynard, a former Marine, Professor Maynard holds a 10th Dan American Combat Jujitsu, 9th Dan Jujitsu (AJA), 9th Dan Jujitsu (JA), and has been inducted into Jujitsu America's Hall of Fame, the World Martial Arts Hall of Fame and Instructor of the Year from both Jujitsu America (JA) and American Jujitsu America (AJA).

Professor Richard Bunch's training in Kodenkan Danzan Ryu Jujitsu began in early childhood. He began training in 1960 with Prof. Bill Montero, Sensei Glen Castlio, Prof. Ray Law and Prof. Sig Kufferath. Prof. Kufferath was regarded as Soke (head) of the Kodenkan Danzan Ryu style. Shortly afterward, in 1968, Prof. Bunch received his Shodan (1st degree black belt) from Prof. Kufferath. In 1971, Prof. Kufferath honored Prof. Bunch by recognizing him as his associate instructor, and later as chief instructor of the school. Over the course of 28 years, Prof. Bunch engaged in constant training and study with Prof. Kufferath at Nikko Jujitsu School. Since then, Prof. Bunch's rank in Kodenkan Danzan Ryu Jujitsu has been elevated to Kudan (9th degree black belt).

Professor Ernie Cates has many accomplishments in the sport of judo that includes his seven consecutive years as the winner of the All Marine Corp Judo Championships in his weight group. Concurrently, he went on to win Grand Champion defeating all other weight group winners for five years in a row, in addition to twice winning the Inner Service Championships. In 1963 he won the Southern United States, AAU Grand Championship.
